

REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF DEPOSITS AND LATE PAYMENT CHARGES

Starting September 15, 2021, residential ComEd customers identified as meeting the requirements of “low-income residential customer or applicant” (and eligible) under Sections 8-201.7 and 8 201.8 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act will have deposits and late payment charges waived.

ComEd residential customers currently receiving LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program) or PIPP (Percent of Income Payment Plan program) benefits under the Energy Assistance Act have been automatically approved and do not need to submit a request.

If you currently live in a zip code listed here, you only need to complete and submit the form. No additional documentation is needed.

For other residential customers and service applicants, to qualify, your household income must be at 80% or less of Area Median Income (AMI) for your county of residence, or you must be eligible for or currently enrolled in a federal Lifeline program. Please complete a brief form and provide documentation regarding your household and household income.

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If you meet the eligibility requirements, we will return the deposit to you within 2 billing cycles.

- The deposit will first be applied to any outstanding balance on your account. If there are any remaining funds, they will automatically be returned to you by check.
- If your account is current, the deposit will automatically be returned to you by check.

In addition, going forward, eligible low-income customers will not be subject to either deposit requirements for new service or late payment charges. If you meet the eligibility requirements, you can expect to enjoy the following benefits:

- You will not be charged late payment fees on your account once your application is approved.
- You will not be assessed a deposit for new service.

You will be required to periodically re-certify to continue enjoying these benefits.

Renewal Deadline Details: For those customers who submit their completed form on or before August 31, 2022, a Company designation of eligibility is effective through December 31, 2022. For those customers who submit their completed form on or after September 1, 2022, a Company designation of eligibility is effective through December 31, 2023. The designation of eligibility may be renewed annually through the above process if and as long as the customer remains eligible. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions regarding the duration of an eligibility designation, eligibility remains subject to the statutory exception relating to tampering with respect to waiver of deposits.

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Types of acceptable documentation to demonstrate eligibility include, but are not limited to:

- Current income documents
 - 2020 state, federal, or Tribal tax return
 - Social Security statement of benefits
 - Veterans Administration statement of benefits
 - Retirement or pension statement of benefits
 - Unemployment or Worker's Compensation statement of benefits
 - Divorce decree, child support award, or a similar official document showing household income
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Medicaid
 - Federal Public Housing www.fcc.gov/general/lifeline-program-low-income-consumers Assistance
 - Tribal-specific programs: Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribally Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TTANF), Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), Head Start
 - Income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Programs
- Loss of income documents (dated within the last 3 months)
 - Layoff/furlough notice
 - Unemployment application, approval letter, or benefit statement
 - Unemployment or Workers' Compensation statement of benefit statement
- Lifeline program enrollment
- Completed No Income form, which is available at ComEd.com/verification

Please submit COPIES of your supporting documentation and retain your originals. DO NOT SEND original documents or original IDs.

Waivers and return of deposit not applicable to customers who have been identified as having benefited from tampering with a ComEd service meter.

Eligibility for these waivers and return of deposit does not qualify you for the Illinois Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), The Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP), Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP), or any other utility financial assistance program.
