Credit to Delivery charges for excess generated electricity.

CARBON-FREE ENERGY RESOURCE ADJUSTMENT
Supports energy resources in IL, fueled by nuclear power and connected to transmission grid, that help minimize carbon emissions. This could be a credit or a charge depending on wholesale energy prices.
