Program Structure

- **Facilitation:** ComEd & Workforce Development Agency
- **Schedule:** 3 Week Program
- **Daily Structure:** The A&B Teams will alternate days between Physical and Educational Assessments for 3 hours each day
- **Frequency:** Offered multiple times a year
- **Student Cost:** FREE
- **Scholarships:** Full scholarships to Dawson Technical Institute (Overhead Electrical Line Worker Program) are available for qualified applicants who successfully complete the ComEd Craft Academy

Academy Requirements

- **Must be at least 18 years old**
- **High school diploma or GED equivalent**
- **Must pass enrollment tests**
- **Have a valid driver's license**
- **Background and drug test**
- **Admissions interview**
