

SMART METER INSTALLATION

ComEd is modernizing the electric grid to build a stronger, more reliable smart grid. Smart meters are important building blocks of the smart grid and will be installed in all homes and businesses across northern Illinois by the end of 2018.

A smart meter is a digital electric meter that securely sends energy-usage information to ComEd. Smart meters provide access to more information about energy use through tools and programs that can help you manage your energy bills. Because smart meters automatically send meter readings to ComEd, they help reduce the need for meter readers to visit your building or business and request access to your facilities, as well as help reduce the number of estimated bills.

If your business has a smart meter, you can go to ComEd's website and create an online account to make bill payments, view outage information, as well as access the following tools and information to help you manage your energy use and save money on your energy bills.

- **View hourly, daily and monthly usage information to help you better understand how your facility uses energy.**
- **Use Green Button Download to share energy-usage information with third-party service providers who can offer products and services related to energy use.**
- **Enroll in High-Usage Alerts and be notified when your energy use is trending higher than usual.**
- **Sign up to receive weekly or monthly reports that summarize your daily use.**
- **Register for Daily Usage Alerts, set a daily threshold amount, and receive an alert after your use has exceeded that amount.**



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING INSTALLATION

Prior to a smart meter being installed at your business, ComEd will contact you with details on when the installation will take place. ComEd will install smart meters in the same location of the existing meters at your building or business. The installation is not expected to interrupt your electric service. In fact, the process is no different than the meter exchanges that have previously taken place at your building or business.
