

NEW MANUFACTURED HOMES ENERGY EFFICIENT EQUIPMENT APPLICATION

January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019

Applications must be received within 30 days of installation or by December 31, 2019, whichever comes first.

The New Manufactured Homes Energy Efficient Equipment offering is designed to achieve energy savings in new manufactured homes for ComEd delivery service customers. Qualifying customers must meet specific income guidelines. Savings are realized through customer implementation of energy efficient measures, offered by the dealer prior to home installation, and targeted to improve the energy efficiency of new manufactured homes. Rebates for each measure are meant to offset the incremental cost of more energy efficient equipment provided by the dealer. Rebates will be paid directly to the dealer.

HOW TO APPLY



CHECK PROJECT AND EQUIPMENT ELIGIBILITY

- ComEd residential customers who purchase a new manufactured home are eligible to participate. Initial application may be submitted at any time but rebates will not be paid until ComEd account number is submitted and validated.
- Residential customers must meet income eligibility guidelines. To qualify, ComEd customers must meet household income at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI).
- All installed equipment must meet or exceed specifications described in this application.



UPGRADE EQUIPMENT PRIOR TO NEW MANUFACTURED HOME INSTALLATION

- The dealer will provide the customer with the ability to upgrade individual measure(s) to more energy efficient measure(s) at the point of purchase, prior to installation of new manufactured home.



SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

- Submit an application as soon as your project is completed, and include the following:
 - A. Completed and signed program application.
 - B. Copy of the new manufactured home bill of sale between the dealer and the ComEd customer with each eligible measure included.
 - C. Dealer must complete and attach a W-9 form.



SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

- When the final application is approved by the program team, a rebate check will be mailed to the dealer. Only registered dealers in good standing may receive rebate payments.

PROGRAM EFFECTIVE DATES

ComEd Energy Efficiency Program rebates are offered until approved funds are exhausted or December 31 of each program year, whichever comes first. The effective dates of this program year are January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.

Subsequent program year budgets and plans will be made available toward the end of the existing program year. At the current time, ComEd has a commitment to provide this program through December 31, 2021.

PROGRAM AND PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

The program offers new manufactured home dealers rebates when the buyer chooses to upgrade individual measures to more energy efficient measures, including a number of ENERGY STAR appliances. The rebate for each measure is to assist in offsetting the price differential between a "base" unit and the more energy efficient model provided by the dealer. Program rebates are available on new manufactured homes sold to income eligible residents (defined as 80% of the area median income) within the ComEd service territory and receive their electricity over ComEd wires, regardless of retail electric supplier. Program rebates are paid directly to dealer and will be reflected on the bill of sale from the dealer to the ComEd customer for each eligible measure. Funds are limited and subject to availability.

Project requirements under the program include the following:

- ✓ Projects must involve new energy efficient equipment installed in a new manufactured home prior to home installation at an address within the ComEd service territory that results in a permanent reduction in electrical energy usage (kWh).
- ✓ Equipment must be installed and operational.
- ✓ Any measures installed in a new manufactured home must be sustainable and provide 100 percent of the energy benefits as stated in the application for a period of five years or for the life of the product, whichever is less. If the customer ceases to be a delivery service customer of ComEd or removes the equipment or system at any time during the five-year period or the life of the product, without having replaced the equipment or system with an equally or more energy efficient equipment or system during that time, the customer may be required to return a prorated amount of rebate funds to ComEd.

Only measures listed on pages 3-4 qualify for incentives under this program.

REBATE PAYMENT LIMITS

Rebate payments cannot exceed the agreed upon pricing that is listed out in this application. Rebate payments are paid out based on quantity of measures installed.

APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS

ComEd will review final applications for eligibility and completeness. The final application must be submitted within 30 days of project completion. The following project documentation is required:

1. Completed and signed program application.
2. Copy of the bill of sale from the dealer to the ComEd customer.

ComEd reserves the right to request additional supporting documentation as deemed necessary to ensure measure eligibility and verify that the expected energy savings will occur. All customer information will be held in confidence. Requested information could include equipment purchase dates, installation dates, proof that the equipment is operational, manufacturer specifications, and warranty information.

Any dealer who submits an incomplete application will be notified of deficiencies upon review of the application; the application will not be processed until all information is received. Dealers are encouraged to call the program hotline at 833-220-0673 if they have any questions about documentation requirements.

INSPECTIONS

ComEd reserves the right to inspect all dealer installation projects to verify compliance with program rules and the accuracy of project documentation. This may include post-installation inspections, metering, data collection, interviews and utility bill data analyses. Upon reasonable notice by ComEd, the customer must allow access to project documents and the facility where the measures were installed for a period of five years after receipt of an incentive payment by ComEd.

TAX LIABILITY

Rebates may be subject to federal and/or state income tax reporting. ComEd is not responsible for providing legal or accounting advice regarding any taxes that may be imposed on your business as a result of your receipt of a service provider partner installation incentive. Customer should consult with its tax accountant or advisor regarding potential tax liability.

DATA USAGE

ComEd reserves the right to use the data collected from the customer for the program evaluation of the New Manufactured Homes program only.

NEW MANUFACTURED HOMES ENERGY EFFICIENT EQUIPMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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DISPUTES/GOVERNING LAW

This application shall be exclusively governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. Any litigation between the parties shall be prosecuted only in the state or federal courts located in Cook County, Illinois.

TOXIC MATERIALS

Neither ComEd, nor its consultants, contractors and/or subcontractors, shall have any responsibility for the discovery, presence, handling, removal, disposal of, or exposure to hazardous materials of any kind in connection with customer's facility, including without limitation, asbestos, asbestos products, PCBs or any other toxic substances.

LOGO USE

Customers or service providers may not use the ComEd company and program names or logos in any marketing, advertising or promotional material without written permission.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

The customer shall independently evaluate any advice or information offered by ComEd related to estimates of electricity savings or program costs and is solely responsible for the selection and implementation of Energy Conservation Measures (ECMs).

IN NO EVENT WILL ComEd, ITS CONSULTANTS, CONTRACTORS AND/OR SUBCONTRACTORS, BE LIABLE FOR THE CUSTOMER'S FAILURE TO ACHIEVE A SPECIFIED AMOUNT OF ENERGY SAVINGS, THE OPERATION OF CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES, OR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT OR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ECMs AT CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES. IN NO EVENT WILL ComEd BE LIABLE TO YOU FOR ANY LOST PROFITS, LOST SAVINGS OR INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, ARISING OUT OF YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THIS PROGRAM.

ComEd, in its sole discretion, may change any of the terms and/or conditions of this program upon 30 days written notice to customer and/or service provider.

ComEd does not guarantee that certain energy savings will be achieved and does not make any warranties associated with the measures eligible for rebates under this program.

ComEd has no obligations regarding, and does not endorse or guarantee any claims, promises, representations, or work made or performed, or equipment furnished or installed by any contractors, subcontractors, or vendors that sell or install energy efficiency measures.

The customer shall be entitled to the energy cost savings realized by the customer that result from the installation of ECMs at the customer's site. In consideration of the services provided by ComEd as part of this program, the customer agrees that ComEd is entitled to 100 percent of the rights and benefits associated with the measures, including without limitation PJM products and all other attributes, credits or products associated therewith under any regional initiative or federal, state or local law, program or regulation, and customer waives, and agrees not to seek, any right to the same.

VERIFICATION

Any Customer receiving a rebate may be contacted by an evaluator to verify service/equipment installation through an onsite inspection, or Customer may be asked to complete a survey about their experience with the rebate program.
